## Introduction of Interests

**Definition:** An interest-based registry records the resulting interests in land, along with their states and attributes, rather than just the transactional documents (instruments) that authorize or modify them.



### Instrument-Based Registry


- Piles of Documents

- Chronological Filing




### Interest-Based Registry





# Aligning Surveys, Parcels & Interests

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New process is being developed jointly developed with Surveyor General Branch:

- Going forward, Surveyor General Branch and the FNLGR will work together to ensure that subdivision surveys will not be recorded in the CLSR without an associated application to subdivide.

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New survey product being jointly developed with Surveyor General Branch

- New product that will replace textual descriptions with a graphical product that can be represented in the mapping
- No field survey required
- For interests less than 10 years in length only

# Understanding the Scale of the Data Transition

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Current data spread across multiple systems  
(ILRS/FNLRS/SGFNLRS)

Over 23,800 existing parcels and 181,210 instruments to migrate

Complex mix of historical and active records requiring analysis

Varying data quality and completeness across systems

Unknown number of parcels lacking NRCAN PINs

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
