LAND DEVELOPMENT PROCEDURES

Land Development Procedures are the guidelines on how to implement development-related Laws. Land Development Procedures clarify the processes that all proponents (including the First Nation itself) must follow for any proposed development on First Nation Lands.

Interests in lands or structures

LAND DEVELOPMENT PROCEDURES

Land Development Procedures help to ensure due diligence is performed by a First Nation, and that land development proposals undergo <u>consistent</u> assessment that support a fair review and approval process <u>before</u> proceeding.

Projects need to be understood for their potential impacts, risks, liabilities and benefits for a community:

- Environment & Climate Change
- Legal Risks & Liabilities
- Cultural Heritage
- Process, Planning & Engagement
- Community Health & Well-being
- Financial & Economic
- Public Works & Infrastructure



For each of these areas, there may be specific Laws, plans, processes, procedures, decisions and expertise to consider, depending on the development.




