

# **GIS Support Services**

Geographical Information Systems (GIS) are an effective tool for Lands Governance under the *Framework Agreement for First Nations Land Management*.

The Planning Hub's GIS Specialist will assist our signatory communities with challenges related to planning, design and maintenance of their GIS under land governance.



## **Specific GIS Support**

The GIS Specialist can assist you in multiple ways, including:

- general troubleshooting and support
- advice on software and equipment purchases\* and compatibility issues
- converting hard copy value added data into digital mapping layers
- integrating and overlaying planning information into GIS
- \* RC will not make equipment or software recommendations, but instead will assist in choosing the right system for the community's needs.



## **Integrating FNLRS Data**

Provide advice and support on how to integrate exported data from the First Nations Land Registry System (FNLRS) into a cadastral layer in GIS. RC can also assist in identifying and importing other electronic land inventory data into GIS that is relevant to Lands Governance needs.



#### **GIS Standards**

Assistance with the development of a community focused GIS manual used to identify specific mapping protocols, projections, symbology, design and data quality control procedures to enhance and support a community's Lands Governance system.



### **Data Library**

Assistance in the design and organization of an electronic land inventory and optimizing data integration to use as a key tool across the organization for managing Lands Governance initiatives.



#### **GIS Needs Assessment**

Direct community support to identify and review GIS resources that may assist the management of specific Lands Governance issues. As well as support in determining a type of system and software that might be most appropriate for your community.
