Background

- First Nations Land Registry System (FNLRS) is used for the land records of First Nations with Land Codes pursuant to the *Framework Agreement on First Nation Land Management* (FA)
- The *First Nations Lands Registry Regulations* provide that the Registrar shall store electronic documents registered or recorded under the Regulations

2000 ILRS	 Users can only access parcel abstract Formal request to INAC for secondary information 			
2010 ILRS/FNLRS/SGFNLRS	General Public SiteClients now able to view secondary information			



Privacy Complaint

- The Privacy Commissioner of Canada assessed that registration documents containing personal information may no longer be accessed on-line by members of the general public
- INAC focused on redacting personal information contained in ILRS documents

Access to Information and Privacy (ATIP)

Access to Information Act

 provides a right of access to information in records under the control of a government institution in accordance with the principles that government information should be available to the public, that necessary exceptions to the right of access should be limited and specific

Privacy Act

 protects the privacy of individuals with respect to personal information about themselves held by a government institution and that provide individuals with a right of access to that information

Considerations

- The Regulations must be considered in light of the Privacy Commissioner's interpretation of sections 7 and 8 of the *Privacy Act* governing the use and disclosure of public information
- Working group established to agree on a solution
