

Community Engagement Strategy: Key Questions to Ask

- » What is the project you are engaging the community on?
- » What does your Land Code/Law say?
- » What is the purpose and scope of engagement?
- » What does successful engagement look like?
- » What level of participation is it hoped will be achieved?
- » Who needs to be engaged?
- » What are their engagement needs & preferences?
- » Who is doing the engagement? You? Consultant?
- » What values inform your engagement?
- » What cultural protocols inform your engagement?

- » How will you collect and store the information you gather?
- » What will you do with what you find out?
- » How will you honour the contributions your members make?

- » What resources, space and equipment do you have available?
- » What's your budget? Time limit?
- » What's your schedule?
- » When and where are you meeting?
- » What tools & techniques will you use to engage?
