

The Framework Agreement recognizes that a First Nation has the full power to enforce its Land Code, and subsequent land and environmental laws. A First Nation has the power to establish comprehensive enforcement procedures, including establishing offences that are punishable on summary conviction, and providing for inspections, searches, seizures, fines, imprisonment, restitution, community service and alternative means for achieving compliance with its laws.

**With proper planning, you can use your Land Code authority to determine what Laws you need, what Laws you have the capacity to implement, how to develop and adopt your Laws, establishing offences under each Law (e.g. environmental offences), and the rules and procedures for:**
