



First Nation Costs



King Bay



- Located by the King Bay Marina
- Serviced by Mid-Ontario Disposal since 2017 (no service agreement with MDPFN)
- Services about 43 First Nation residences & about 200 local boaters accessing Georgian Bay through King Bay
- Services paid by cottage association May 1 to Nov 1 (3x/week and recycling 2x/week)
- Services paid by District of Muskoka Apr and Nov
- Services paid by MDPFN Dec 1 to Mar 31
- ▶ Generally, very well maintained

Isaac Bay



- Located at cross-road of Twelve Mile Bay Rd and Ryder's Rd
- ▶ 2 waste bins, no recycling
- Serviced by WasteConnections of Canada -1x/week
- Challenge: maintaining the area - garbage and large items often spread around the bins. Who is responsible to clean it?

Community Centre



- Located at the 'Blue Shed'
- ▶ 2 recycling bins, no waste
- Serviced by Waste Connections of Canada -1x/week
- Challenge: maintaining the area - large items often dropped off in evenings/weekends when unmonitored, despite No Dumping signs

MDP Marina



- Located at MDP Marina
- 2 waste bins, 2 recycling bins
- Serviced by WasteConnections of Canada1x/week
- Paid by MDP Marina
- Services about 250 boats docked at the marina

Large Items



- Maintenance crew haul construction material and large items to landfill in Gravenhurst
- Annual large item pick up from 75 residences
- Invoiced by District of Muskoka
- Paid by MDPFN
