

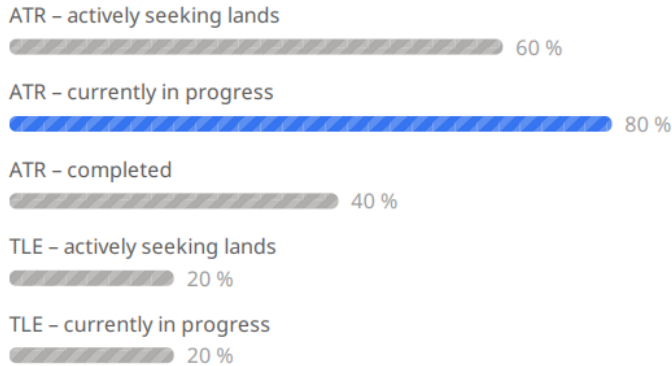

boundaries. BC has known about many of Doig River's land selection interests since 2008, but didn't even look at them seriously until 2018. We think we're almost settled now. In Alberta, all TLE settlement land becomes Reserve with mineral rights. BC's position was that they only owe reserve land for the shortfall, and any "additional lands" will be provided in fee simple. They have since agreed that some of the "additional lands" will be supported for immediate Addition To Reserve, but won't include mineral rights. You will have to negotiate with BC as to how much of the additional lands will become reserve, and then negotiate with your community as to which land is owned as shortfall, ATR, or fee simple.
