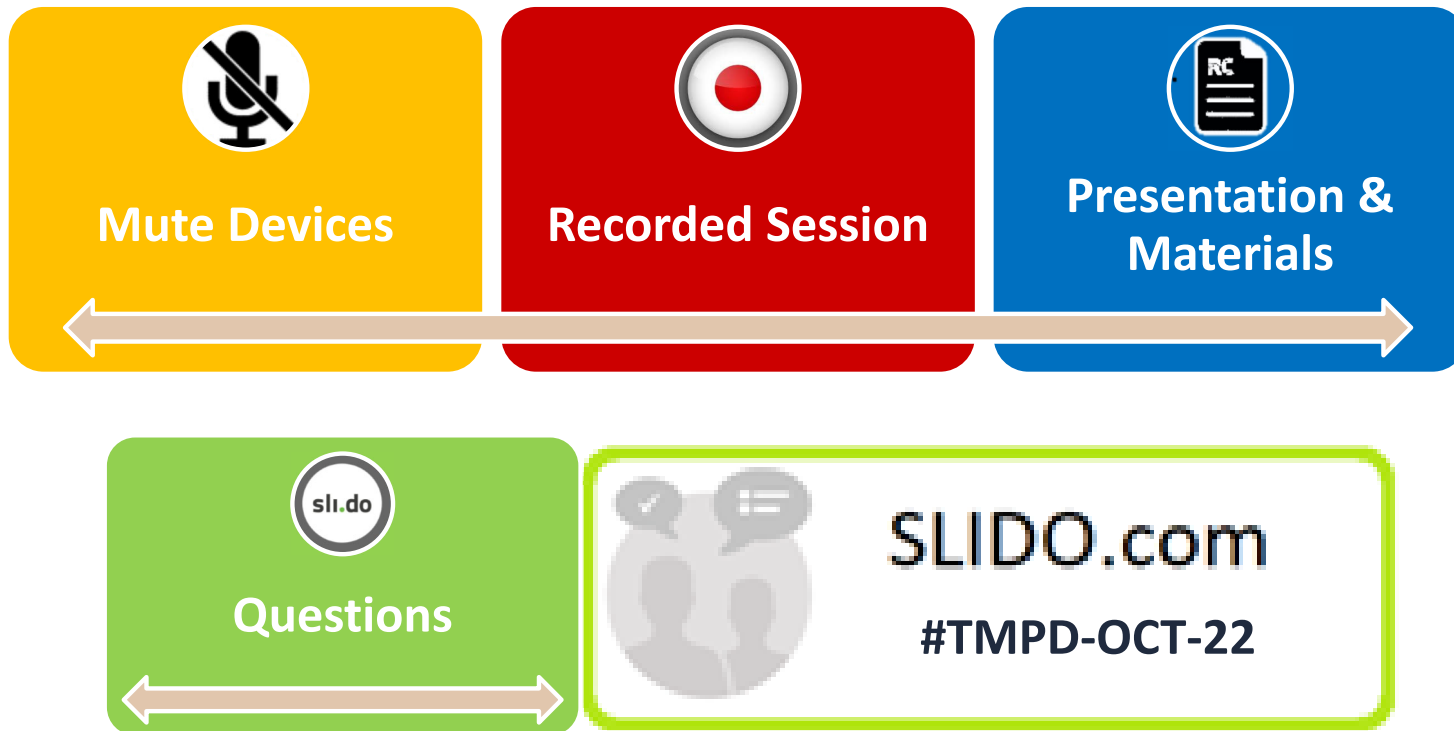

Bylaw Enforcement & Pandemic Planning



COVID-19 laws under land code contribute indirectly to health & safety

Emergency plans can include Pandemic Response

Maintaining community support for COVID-19 laws and guidelines

Federal Policy only enforcing COVID-19 bylaws under Indian Act

Land Code COVID-19 laws can include stronger penalties

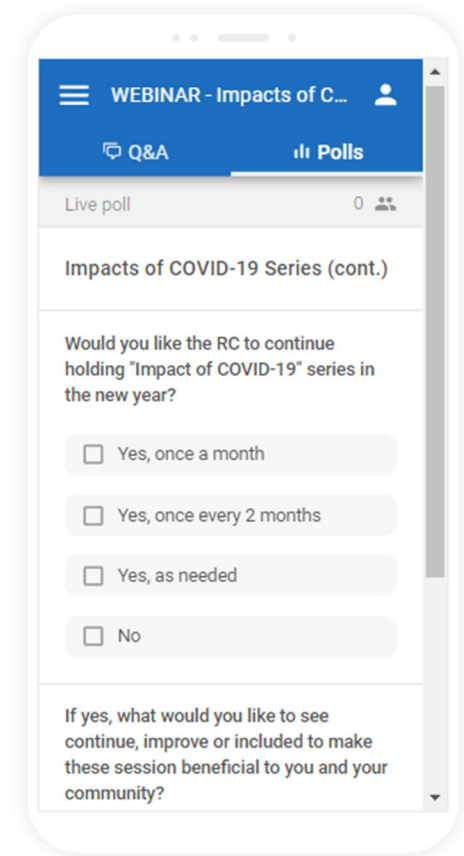
