FRAMEWORK AGREEMENT



Framework Agreement

- Specifies that a First Nation shall have the option of exercising control over their lands and resources ...
- Section 5 identifies what "will" be in a Land Code and subjects that "may" be put in your land code.



Land Code



- It's a law
- Sets rules & procedures for land code governance
- Outlines roles & responsibilities
- Must be consistent with the Framework Agreement
- Decisions must be consistent with a First Nation's land code
- Land Code should reinforce other laws



WHY THE NEW LAND CODE MODELS?



- ✓ Simplifies procedural requirements
- ✓ Plain language drafting
- ✓ Emphasis on the most important land governance issues (e.g. allotments & law-making procedures)
- ✓ Less emphasis on issues that rarely arise (e.g. expropriation & dispute resolution)





OPTIONS FOR LAND CODE AMENDMENTS





Land Codes require approval of a majority of First Nations members through a vote ... amendments also typically require a majority vote of members.

Some land codes only allow Chief & Council to make minor amendments to correct grammar or make necessary updates.

Other land codes authorize Chief & Council to deal with typographical errors, correcting cross-references, and even minor amendments which do not alter the meaning of a provision of a land code.







LAND CODE MODELS



- Your draft land code should be reviewed by legal counsel
- Our "model" land codes include procedures which you may wish to modify for your First Nation (e.g. suggested wording for community meetings, procedural steps for making laws, etc.)
- Our model includes "land rights" of members and other residents which you may wish to modify for your First Nation (e.g. consider who owns or gets revenues from natural resources on your lands, etc.)






