Classes: Introduction to First Nation Taxation, Establishing First Nation Tax Rates and Expenditures, Assessment and Assessment Appeals, Administration: Tax Notices, Collection & Enforcement, Communications, Taxpayer Relations and Dispute Resolution, Service Agreements and Joint Contracts, Development Cost Charges, Capital Infrastructure and Debenture Financing.

Classes: Resource Development on First Nation Lands, and Investment Facilitation on First Nation Lands.


