





#### **What We Do**


The Resource Centre is dedicated to supporting First Nations communities, when invited, in the following ways:

- The RC works with First Nations in relation to their reserve lands to support Lands Governance Offices,
   Lands Advisory Committees, as well as Chief and Council
- RC does not advise individual band members, businesses or corporations
- RC advisory role is not a substitute for professional services to the First Nation (lawyers, accountants, engineers, land use planners etc.)
- RC staff may be accompanied by LAB directors for Chief and Council discussions where political engagement strategies are to be discussed
- RC support to lands offices can include assistance in engaging with outside agencies
- RC First Nation Support Technicians are your primary service contacts they can find other supports within the RC
