Framework Agreement Amendment #7

WHEREAS, pursuant to Clause 39.1 (h) of the Framework Agreement on First Nation Land Management, the Lands Advisory Board has the designated function of proposing to the Minister such amendments to this Agreement and the federal legislation as it considers necessary or advisable;

AND WHEREAS the Lands Advisory Board and Resource Centre have entered into discussions with Canada on a set of proposed amendments that will expedite implementation of the Framework Agreement by those developmental First Nations who have signed;

AND WHEREAS the Lands Advisory Board considers that an Amendment # 7, based on the attached recommendations, is both necessary and advisable at this time:

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

That the Chair and Executive of the Lands Advisory Board are directed to pursue negotiations with Canada for an Amendment # 7 to the Framework Agreement on First Nation Land Management based on the recommendations set out in the attached Background Document and to report to the Board and to the First Nations on the progress of those negotiations.

1. That the Chair and Executive of the Lands Advisory Board are directed to pursue negotiations with Canada for an Amendment # 7 to the Framework Agreement on First Nation Land Management based on the recommendations set out in the attached Background Document and to report to the Board and to the First Nations on the progress of those negotiations.
2. That, if and when there is agreement with Canada on the content of Amendment # 7, the Chair and Executive make appropriate arrangements for the Amendment to be submitted to the First Nations that have ratified the Framework Agreement, 2/3 of which are required to approve any amendment to the Framework Agreement.
3. That the Lands Advisory Board forward Amendment # 7, as approved by the First Nations, to the Minister of Crown – Indigenous Relations and Northern Affairs.
